



ALPACA SHEARING - TRAILERDAY PROGRAM 2020

Shearers:

Our main shearer James Wheeler has many years' experience shearing alpacas, and shears large numbers through South Australia, Queensland, and some years into New South Wales and Victoria. For various reasons, there are less shearers around this year and time has come to increase our team. We welcome our apprentice shearer Emily Waters to the team. Some of you will have met Emily in previous years when she has helped in our sheds and we are excited that she has decided to take up shearing.

Cost:

Regrettably, after five years at the same price, we have had to raise the price this year as a result of increased costs. \$40 per alpaca including shearing, toenails, checking teeth, vaccination and vitamin AD&E shots for alpacas in one year fleece. A surcharge will apply to alpacas in more than one year's fleece due to the extra time required to shear them and the extra wear and tear on equipment.

For those of you who have been to this venue before, the following information has changed.

Once you turn onto Coomooloo Road, follow the signs to Yaringa Alpacas at the end of the road. Once on the property Coomooloo, take the right hand fork in the driveway. Pass between the two houses and turn left across the front of the shearing shed. This year we will be shearing at ground level inside the sliding door – there will be pens outside for you to unload your animals into.

If you are bringing just one or two animals and they are halter trained, you may prefer to park in front of the house and walk your animals around.
